The Davis Family YMCA is hosting its fifth annual juried art show in conjunction with National YMCA Arts Month.

But I Know What I Like is open to any adult, amateur or professional within a 40 mile radius. The twist is that it will be judged by non-experts, as in "I don't know much about art, but I know what I like!"

All family friendly art will be accepted.

Cash prizes will be awarded.

Eligibility

- * Open to adults within a 40 mile radius.
- * Original works completed in the last 3 years.

Specifications

- * All two dimensional pieces and small ceramics and sculptures will be accepted provided they are family friendly.
- * **2-D pieces must be framed, wired, and ready to hang.**
- * Maximum size 40" in any direction, not to exceed 25 pounds.
- * All pieces labeled on the back top left hand corner.

Liability

While every precaution will be taken to care for the art, the YMCA is not responsible for any loss or damage.

Sales

Any sales made during the exhibition are subject to a 25% sales commission, with proceeds going to the Patterson Art Scholarship fund. Checks mailed within 30 days of sale.

Entry Procedure

- * Up to three pieces may be entered. \$20 for first two pieces, additional \$5 for the third.
- * The entry fee for one piece will be waived for anyone who has taken an Arts & Humanities Class at the Davis Family YMCA in 2018. Additional pieces are \$5 each.
- * Pieces to be dropped off at the YMCA, 45 McClurg Rd, Boardman, on Friday, Sept 28 from 10am-5pm, or Saturday, Sept 29 from 10-3:30pm.
- * Please have complete entry form and cash or check ready when dropping off artwork. Indicate sale price, POR (prices on request), or NFS (not for sale)

Return of Artwork

- * Pieces to be removed from the YMCA November 18th-25th from 10am-5pm.
- * You must stop at the desk to sign form before removing art from the Y.
